## Knights' Jones player of the week for second week

**Menomonie, Wis.** (January 30, 2006) - Despite seeing his scoreless streak ended, St. Norbert goalie Kyle Jones (So, North Delta, British Columbia) was named the NCHA player of the week after he posted two wins over two of the top three teams in the league over the weekend.

Jones led St. Norbert to a pair of big road wins this past weekend to increase its lead in the NCHA to three points, with the Green Knights beat River Falls 7-0 and Stout 5-1. Jones pitched a 30-save shutout against River Falls - his fourth straight overall. He narrowly missed a fifth against Stout, making 21 saves, and allowed a goal with just 2:38 left in the game. Jones saw his consecutive shutout sequence end at a staggering 337 minutes 22 seconds. He has six shutouts this season, 11 in his career, and has allowed just 13 goals in 10 NCHA games this season.

## The Week Ahead

While seven teams are still mathematically in the chase for the conference title, St. Norbert put a big-time stamp on their passport for another conference title by whipping the second and third place teams - UW-River Falls, 7-0, and UW-Stout, 5-1, over the weekend and take a three point league lead over second play River Falls.

St. Norbert goalie Kyle Jones saw his shutout streak come to an end at 337-plus minutes when Stout scored with three minutes left to play.

Those that have been around the league for quite some time say that this is one of the tightest races in a long time. St. Norbert needs to win three of their last four games to clinch their fifth straight NCHA title. For second place River Falls to claim the title,

they must win all four games and St. Norbert would have to lose at least two. If the Falcons drop a game anywhere, the Green Knights could claim the crown with two wins.

St. Scholastica, UW-Stevens Point, UW-Stout, UW-Superior and Lake Forest all have mathematical chances at a conference crown and are separated by only three points from third place to seventh place. Stout does battle with St. Scholastica and UW-Superior. The Pointers will tangle with Lake Forest and St. Norbert. The Saints will face River Falls, as will Superior.

The Green Knights stayed at No. 2 in the latest USCHO.com poll, but picked up three first place votes. The Falcons dropped two spots to No. 6, while St. Scholastica stayed at No. 9.
