Hat trick plus one lifts Knights' Cote to honors

Menomonie, Wis. (February 6, 2006) - St. Norbert forward Andy Cote scored five goals to lead the Green Knights to a perfect 2-0 record over the weekend and within one win of clinching the NCHA regular season championship. Cote was selected as the NCHA player of the week.

Cote scored one marker in Friday's 6-0 win over UW-Eau Claire, and then tallied four goals as St. Norbert beat UW-Stevens Point 6-1 in front of a SNC-record 5,516 at Resch Center in Green Bay. Three of Cote's goals on the weekend were on the power play. On the season, Cote has 10 goals in NCHA play, a league high.

Also nominated for player of the week were: Lake Forest forward Tyler Canal (Jr, Thunder Bay, Ontario); UW-River Falls goalie AJ Bucchino (So, Bow, NH); UW-Superior forward Pat Power (Fr, Winnipeg, Manitoba).

The Week Ahead

St. Norbert has put itself in position to capture their fifth consecutive NCHA crown. The Green Knights, who this week moved to No. 1 in the USCHO.com poll, need one point this weekend to claim the No. 1 seed. St. Norbert will have to get past Lake Forest College in a home-and-home series. St. Norbert will be at Lake Forest Friday, Feb. 10 and will host the Foresters, Saturday, Feb. 11.

Peters Cup play will get underway Friday, Feb. 17. Only St. Norbert and UW-River Falls have locked up home bids for the first round of the playoffs.

UW-River Falls can fall no lower than the second seed. If the Falcons falter and drop both games to UW-Stout this weekend, and St. Scholastica beats UW-Superior twice, both River Falls and Scholastica would have 17 points and the same number of conference wins. River Falls holds the tie-breaker with the Saints by virtue of outscoring the

Saints, 8-5, in the Falcons' two wins.

After that it, is up for grabs between St. Scholastica, UW-Superior, Lake Forest, UW-Stevens Point and Stout. Any combination of wins and losses muddles up the middle.

River Falls coach Steve Freeman (198-83-19) needs two wins to reach 200.

NCHA Peters Cup Playoff Tie-Breakers

A. The opponents will be determined by their finish in the NCHA Conference standing.

B. In case there is a tie in the standings among one or more teams, the ranking will be determined by the following criteria, in this order:

1. If the teams are tied for the same place, the team winning most conference games between the schools will be ranked higher.

2. If a tie still exists, the greater goal differential in the conference games played between the schools will be used as the determining factor.

3. If a tie still exists, the goal differential in all conference games will be the determining factor.
