## The Week Ahead

It was pretty much status quo in the quarterfinals round of the Peters Cup playoffs – with one exception. The semi-finals will have a first time player in UW-Stout, which will be making its first trip past the first round after sweeping past UW-River Falls. The No. 7 seeded Blue Devils gave coach Terry Watkins his 100<sup>th</sup> career win Friday, Feb. 17 with a 1-0 win, breaking a streak of Friday night losses. Stout brushed the ice with the Falcons Saturday, Feb. 18 with a 3-2 overtime win on an empty-net goal by Andrew Stearns.

In other action, top seeded St. Norbert defeated UW-Eau Claire, 3-1, 5-1; No. 3 UW-Superior moved past St. Scholastica, 4-2, 4-4; and No. 4 Lake Forest continued their dominance over UW-Stevens Point, 5-2, 4-1.

Stout will travel to Green Bay Saturday, Feb. 25 to face the top-ranked Green Knights, while Lake Forest will make the long trip to Superior to face the Yellowjackets. The winners in the one-game series will meet Saturday, March 4 at the highest remaining seed.

The Blue Devils have not had much success over St. Norbert. Stout has not had a win over the Green Knights since Feb. 8, 1970. This season, St. Norbert blanked Stout, 4-0, Dec. 2 and took out the brooms, Jan. 28 with a 5-1 win in Menomonie.

Superior is 2-0 against Lake Forest this season. The Yellowjackets grabbed a 4-1 win over the Foresters, Nov. 19 in Superior and completed the regular season streak, Jan. 20, with a 3-2 win. Superior had to come from behind for that win, scoring two goals in the third period, including the game winner, a short-handed goal by Cory Lennartson with less than three minutes left in the game.

Following is a brief review of the weekend's games.

### St. Norbert vs. UW-Eau Claire

St. Norbert struggled a bit in the opener before coming up with the 3-1 win. The Knights did not put Eau Claire away until they got an

empty net goal from Jeremy Mitchell with about a minute left in the game. The rematch the following night was no contest as St. Norbert scored the first five goals of the game, all power play goals, and Connor Hughes scored a hat trick, getting three consecutive goals over a nine minute stretch beginning late in the first period.

### UW-River Falls vs. UW-Stout

Stout got a power play goal by Cory Mozak two minutes into the game, and Blue Devil goalie Mike Stone made the 1-0 shutout standup. Stout outshot the Falcons, 40-21. Stone picked up his third win in a row over the Falcons (Stout defeated River Falls, 3-1, Feb. 11) with a 3-2 overtime decision. Stone had 40 saves as Stout again outshot River Falls, 48-42. Andrew Stearns got the game-winner, taking a pass from Matt Mlynarczyk for the empty-netter.

### UW-Superior vs. St. Scholastica

Superior twice had to come from behind to take a 4-3 series opening win, Feb. 17. The two teams traded goals in the first and second periods, with the Saints scoring first on a Kelly Reynolds goal, followed up by Myles Palliser power play goal for the Yellowjackets. The Saints' Shawn Barlette put Scholastica ahead in the second, but the lead was short-lived as Nate Rein tied it up. The 'Jackets got two goals in the final period, one by Mike Bickley and the eventual game-winner by Colin Guiguet. The Saints tacked on a final goal. In a 4-4 tie the following day, the Saints' Steve Kordyban got the game-tying goal with eight minutes remaining in regulation to send the game into overtime. St. Scholastica got off three shots in overtime, but none got past Mathieu Bonnelly.

### Lake Forest vs. UW-Stevens Point

Lake Forest goalie Scott Campbell made 47 saves in a 4-1 win over the Pointers, Feb. 18, backing up a 40 save performance by Brandon Kohuch the night before in a 5-2 win. The Foresters scored the first three goals of the game, before the Pointers came back with two goals. LFC's Brian Lee had two goals.
