DeHoey repeats as NCHA player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (January 9, 2006) - Lake Forest forward Courtney DeHoey (So, Chatham, Ont) had a hand in all three goals as the Foresters upended sixth ranked Elmira College, Jan. 7, and DeHoey becomes the first player to repeat as NCHA player of the week.

Against Elmira, DeHoey scored the team's first two goals in a 3-1 win in Elmira, then assisted on an empty net goal late in the game to seal the win. DeHoey scored the team's first two goals in an evenual 5-3 loss to Hamilton College, Jan. 4. DeHoey scored the game opening goal, then gave the Foresters a 2-1 lead in the second period on a shorthanded goal. DeHoey leads the NCHA in scoring with 23 points and in goals with 13. She is tied for second in assists with 10. DeHoey was also named the NCHA player of the week Nov. 28.

The Week Ahead

With the exception of one weekend in February, just about all of the games from here-on out will be of the NCHA variety, and that variety gets underway this weekend as conference action heats up.

UW-Stevens Point and UW-Superior will face off Saturday in one of two key conference matches. The Yellowjackets will then turn around to host upstart Lake Forest.

Superior (9 pts) is currently one point in front of Lake Forest (8) and UW-River Falls (8). The Falcons play a series of three non-conference games with eastern schools.

The Pointers are currently in fourth place with six points, but a strong weekend could propel them to the top. Finlandia can play into the mix as they host Lake Forest Saturday and Stevens Point Sunday.

Superior and River Falls both moved up in the latest USCHO.com poll, while Stevens Point didn't budge. Superior moved up two spots to sixth, while the Falcons moved up one spot to ninth. The Pointers stayed at seventh. Lake Forest is hanging around in the "received votes" group.
