Point's Lunneborg is NCHA player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (January 23, 2006) - UW-Stevens Point forward Kim Lunneborg (Sr, Richfield, Minn) scored two key goals and assisted on a third as the Pointers moved into first place of the NCHA. Lunneborg was named the NCHA player of the week.

Lunneborg contributed on the game's first two goals in Saturday's 6-1 win over UW-Eau Claire and scored the first goal of the game in a 4-1 decision over UW-River Falls Sunday. Against the Blugolds, Lunneborg assisted on the first goal of the game, then scored shorthanded the eventual game winner. Against the Falcons, she scored the first goal of the game 53 seconds into the contest.

Also nominated were: UW-River Falls forward Jenna Scanlon (So, Apple Valley, Minn); UW-Superior forward Alicia Cowieson (Fr, Souris, Manitoba).

The Week Ahead

UW-Stevens Point took advantage of their weekend, taking wins over UW-Eau Claire and UW-River Falls to edge into first place by one point over UW-Superior.

The Pointers are idle this week, and the Yellowjackets would retake the league lead with a single win. The 'Jackets will be at Eau Claire Friday, then travel to UW-River Falls Saturday. The Falcons, who are currently in fourth in the NCHA, will host Finlandia Sunday. Finlandia and Eau Claire meet Saturday. Third place Lake Forest is idle this week.

After this week, the teams will take a break for conference play and will play a series of games against Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (MIAC) teams, Feb. 3, 4 and 7.

Superior's Erin Kegley leads the league

in at least five statistical categories - points (29, 1.93/g), goals (16, 1.07/g), assists (13 (0.87/g), game winning goals (3 in 15 games), and short-handed goals (3).

Superior, which leads the league in goals per game scored (4.38/g) and goals allowed (1.38/g) splits time in the goal with conference leading Kristy Faechner (1.28 goals against average) and Rikki Nespor (1.44 GAA). The Pointers' Amy Statz has guarded the goal in 16-of-17 Stevens Point games and has a 1.45 GAA.

There was no movement of NCHA teams in the latest USHOC.com poll. Stevens Point stayed at sixth and Superior at seventh. Point and Superior have finished their regular season conference meetings with the Pointers getting the edge, 2-0-1.
