Statz sets Pointer shutout record, player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (February 20, 2006) - UW-Stevens Point goalie Amy Statz (Jr, Wisconsin Rapids, Wis.) posted her 13th career shutout, a Stevens Point record as she helped the Pointers stay in first place with two wins over the weekend. Statz was named the NCHA player of the week.

Statz set the Stevens Point career shutout record in a 4-0 win over Lake Forest Saturday, then came back with a 3-1 win over the Foresters on Sunday. The only goal Statz gave up on the weekend was on a 3-on-5 power play.

Also nominated were: UW-Eau Claire defender Allie Campbell (Jr, Plymouth, Minn./Wayzata); UW-Superior forward Jamie McClintock (Fr, Stone Wall, Manitoba).

The Week Ahead

The field is set for the upcoming playoffs as the NCHA heads into its final weekend of regular season play. The only question remains is who will be the top seed and host the two-day tournament March 4-5?

UW-Stevens Point, UW-Superior, UW-River Falls and Lake Forest have all clinched spots in the tournament. River Falls, which has completed its regular season, has a lock on the No. 3 seed and Lake Forest, which hosts Superior, is the No. 4 seed. Neither team can move up or down in the final conference standings.

One point up on Superior in the standings, the Pointers, last year's champion and preseason favorite, controls its own destiny. Sitting on top with 21 points, Stevens Point will host Finlandia Friday, Feb. 24 and Saturday, Feb. 24. Superior trails the Pointers by a point and will be at Lake Forest. The Pointers need a win and a tie (three points) to assure themselves the No. 1 seed and a share of the title with the Yellowjackets. Stevens Point holds the head-to-head tiebreaker with the Yellowjackets, posting a 2-0-1 record that goes back to games in early November.

For Superior to take the title, they would

have to twice defeat Lake Forest and Stevens Point would have to tie twice or lose twice. Any loss by Superior, and the Pointers would need only a tie to clinch at least a share of the title.

Stevens Point defeated Finlandia, 5-1, in the team's first meeting in January, while Superior defeated Lake Forest, 4-1, the same day.

Both teams are on a roll. Stevens Point is 9-0-1 since Jan. 14, the day they knocked off the Yellowjackets, 1-0. The Pointers' only blemish during that run is a 1-1 tie to UW-Eau Claire, Feb. 11. The Yellowjackets are on a six game winning streak and have an 8-1-1 record during the same stretch. They have the Jan. 11 loss to the Pointers and a 1-1 tie with Eau Claire, Jan. 27.

Speaking of Eau Claire, ties has almost become synonymous with the Blugolds this year. Eau Claire finished their regular season with six ties, all in conference play. After tying with Finlandia, 0-0, Feb. 17, another tie looked imminent the next day. With the score knotted at 4-4, Jessie Boyles' goal with less than four minutes left broke the tie and ended Eau Claire's season on a winning note.
