## Pointers' LaClair shuts her way out to NCHA honors

**Menomonie, Wis.** (February 27, 2006) - UW-Stevens Point goalie Julie LaClair (So, White Bear Lake, Minn) posted two shutouts over the weekend as the Pointers clinched their second straight NCHA title and was named the player of the week.

LaClair stopped all 12 shots in Friday's 5-0 win over Finlandia and then made 11 saves, including six in the third period, to preserve a 1-0 title-clinching win over the Lions on Saturday. LaClair made just her second and third starts of the season in the critical series, filling in for regular goaltender Amy Statz.

Also nominated was: UW-Superior forward Erin Kegley (Jr, Inver Grove Heights, Minn).

## Stevens Point to host O'Brien Cup series

UW-Stevens Point clinched it's second consecutive NCHA title, and did it with back-to-back shuouts over Finlandia over the weekend. The Pointers got a solid performance from back-up goalie Julie LaClair, who started both games, posted a 5-0 win Friday, Feb. 24 and a tenuous 1-0 win to lock up the title, Saturday, Feb. 25.

The Pointers were forced to win one game and secure at least a tie in the other, because UW-Superior was breathing right down their neck. The Yellowjackets, who trailed the Pointers by one point heading into the weekend, swept past Lake Forest, 5-0, Feb. 24 and took a 5-3 win earlier in the day, Feb. 25.

Stevens Point, which boasts the top-ranked defense in the NCAA Division III, has allowed just 28 goals in 25 games this season. Saturday's game was the team's third straight shutout as the Pointers have surrendered just six goals in their current 12-game streak.

The Pointers, and LaClair, making only her third start, allowed Finlandia just 11 shots on goal in the game and withstood a furious flurry in the final minutes as the Lions played with an extra attacker for the final 1:37 of the game.

The game remained scoreless until the third period when freshman Nicole Grossmann provided the game winner at the 6:35 mark.

The win also gave the Pointers the No. 1 seed and the right to host the NCHA O'Brien Cup Championship series this weekend. The O'Brien Cup has been named in honor of Frank O'Brien, who played a major role in getting

women's hockey established in the collegiate ranks in the Midwest. The Pointers will host No. 4 Lake Forest, Friday, March 2 at 4 p.m., while No. 2 Superior will take on No. 3 UW-River Falls at 7:30 p.m. The Championship game will be Saturday, March 4 at 7:30 p.m., while the third place game will be at 4 p.m. in KD Willett Arena. All the other games will be in Ice Hawks Arena.

The Pointers went 2-0-1 against the Foresters, with the Foresters forging a 2-2 tie on Dec. 6 at Stevens Point. The Pointers took both games in Lake Forest, winning 3-1, Feb. 18 and shutting out the Foresters, 4-0, the following day.

The Pointers' 12-game streak reaches back to a 1-0 win over Superior, Jan. 14. The Pointers tied UW-Eau Claire, 1-1, on Feb. 11.

The Foresters will be looking for a way to win, something that has eluded them since Jan. 14.

Superior has swept the three-game series with the Falcons, getting a 2-1 win at River Falls, Jan. 28, and a pair of home wins, a 5-2 victory Feb. 18 and a 4-3 win the following day, when Superior scored twice in the third period to hold off the Falcons.

Superior is currently riding an eight game winning streak and an 11 game unbeaten streak stretching back to Jan. 15. The Yellowjackets' last loss was the 1-0 loss to Stevens Point in Superior.

River Falls was idle last weekend, a weekend after being swept by Superior, Feb. 18-19.
