Finlandia's Syrowik keys win, is player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (December 13, 2005) - When it came down to crunch time, Finlandia University forward Danielle Syrowik provided a game-tying assist and put in the game-winning goal in overtime as the Lions picked up their first-ever Northern College Hockey Association (NCHA) win, Dec. 10 in Hancock, Mich. Syrowik was given the NCHA player of the week award for her efforts.

Trailing 3-2 to UW-River Falls, Dec. 10, Syrowiak, a sophomore from Shelby Township, Mich, assisted Sara Sleik with the game-tying goal with 41 seconds remaining in the third period to send the game into overtime, then scored the game-winner with 37 seconds remaining in the extra period to give the Lions a 4-3 win. The Lions split with the Falcons for the weekend, falling 5-1 on Dec. 11.

The NCHA quiets down for the upcoming Christmas break and, of course, finals for the student/athletes. The only game on the docket this week is No. 6 UW-Stevens Point traveling to No. 3 Gustavus Adolphus, Tuesday night. The Pointers will be looking to avenge a 4-3 early season loss to the Gusties in November.

The Pointers will get things going again in January when they make a trip to New England to face Bowdoin College on Jan. 3. Five of the league's six teams will return to action the week after New Year's Day. NCHA action will resume January 14.

UW-Superior, with a sweep of UW-

Eau Claire, edged their way past Lake Forest College, in the standings and will carry a one point lead in the league over the Foresters.

Lake Forest and UW-Stevens Point battled to a 2-2 tie in Stevens Point, Dec. 6. Courtney DeHoey scored the game-tying goal just before the final buzzer to give the Foresters the tie.

Finlandia picked up their first-ever NCHA win, and the Lions did it in dramatic fashion, tying the game with 41 seconds left with UW-River Falls, Dec. 10, then going on for the overtime win.

Stevens Point dropped a spot to No. 7 in the USHOC.com poll and Lake Forest has picked up some votes.
