Twenty Named to NCHA Women's All-Academic Team

Twenty student-athletes have been named to the 2006-07 women's NCHA All-Academic team.

UW-Stevens Point goalie Amy Statz (Sr, Wisconsin Rapids, Wis) received the NCHA Scholar-Athlete Award. Statz, who was named to the All-Academic team for the third time, is an Athletic Training major, with a minor in youth camps program management with a 3.66 grade point average. To be eligible for the scholar-athlete award, the student must maintain a minimum GPA of 3.50 and be in their final year of eligibility.

UW-Superior defenseman Susie Crabb (Sr, Whitby, Ont/Video Productions), UW-River Falls goalie Amber Lindner (Sr, Moorhead, Minn/Communicative Disorders), and UW-Eau Claire forward Amber Stevenson (Sr, Eagan, Minn/Nursing) join Statz for the third time on the team. UW-Eau Claire defenseman Allison Campbell (Sr, Plymouth, Minn/Nursing) and forwards Martina Korinek (Sr, White Bear Lake, Minn/Kinesiology) and Laura Suppes (Sr, Roseville, Minn/Environmental Science), Lake Forest College forwards Michelle Ricketts (Sr, Rochester, Mich/French Communications) and Katie Snowden (Sr, Toronto, Ont/Psychology), UW-Stevens Point defenseman Chris Hanson (Sr, South St. Paul, Minn/Psychology), and Finlandia University forward Jana Riutta (Sr, Houghton, Mich/Nursing) were named for the second year.

Thirteen seniors were named to the all-academic team. Finlandia University led the way with six student-athletes.

To be named to the team a player must have a cumulative 3.00 grade point average, have earned at least 50 semester or 75 quarter hours, and be recommended by her head coach.
