Stout's Mike Stone named NCHA player of the week

MENOMONIE, Wis (January 29, 2007) - UW-Stout goalie **Mike Stone (Jr, West St. Paul, Minn)** kept the Blue Devils' conference record unblemished this weekend with two road wins, allowing only one goal in each game as Stout (18-1-2, 9-0-1 NCHA, 5-0-0 WIAC) defeated Lake Forest, 4-1, Friday, then defeated fourth ranked St. Norbert, 2-1, in Green Bay, Saturday, to stay in first place. Stone was named the NCHA player of the week.

Against St. Norbert, Stone turned away 32 shots, including a flurry of 18 shots in the second period and 10 shots in the third period to give Stout their 11th win in a row and their 13th game without a loss. Stone had 24 saves in the win over Lake Forest. On the weekend, Stone posted a .966 save percentage by stopping 56-of-58 shots. On the season, Stone has a 12-1-1 overall record, with a 1.81 goals against average, 331 saves for a save percentage of .935. The win over St. Norbert was the first time a Stout varsity program has defeated a St. Norbert varsity program. Stone has eight wins over the last eight games played, starting seven games and picking up one win in relief.

Also nominated was St. Scholastica forward AJ Tucker (So, Fort Frances, Ont), Lake Forest goalie Brandon Kohuch (So, Windsor, Ont), UW-River Falls forward Derek Hansberry (So, Arvada, Colo) and UW-Superior forward Corey Lennartson (So, Cloquet, Minn).

The Week Ahead

With only two weekends of league play remaining, the playoff situation is becoming a little clearer, but nothing has been set, even though UW-Stout has taken a four point lead over second play UW-River Falls.

The Blue Devils did what they needed to to remain on top of the league, and got some help along the way to extend their lead. Stout defeated Lake Forest and St. Norbert last weekend, with both games on the road.

St. Norbert opened the weekend with a win over the Falcons, and the Falcons followed with tie with Lake Forest to take only one point out of the weekend.

St. Scholastica had a perfect, four point weekend to stay in contention, defeating UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point. Eau Claire disrupted UW-Superior's weekend with a tie.

Stout will host Scholastica, then will head to Superior Saturday, Feb. 3. The Saints will be at UW-River Falls Saturday. St. Norbert will be at UW-Eau Claire and UW-Stevens Point.

USCHO.com Division III poll, while River Falls dropped from the third spot to the sixth spot. St. Norbert stayed at fourth, and Superior stayed at seventh. St. Scholastica and Eau Claire are both receiving votes.

The Blue Devils are ranked No. 1 in the National Pairwise Rankings (PWR), while St. Norbert was fifth, River Falls seventh and Superior, eighth. The PWR uses five criteria: winning percentage, Quality of Wins Index, head-to-head record, record against common opponents and record against teams currently ranked by the NCAA.
