Falcons' Bucchino takes final NCHA player of the week

MENOMONIE, Wis (February 12, 2007) - UW-River Falls goalie **AJ Bucchino (Jr, Bow, NH)** came up with two strong games in helping the Falcons take a share of the NCHA regular season championship and the No. 1 seed in the NCHA playoffs. Bucchino was named the NCHA player of the week for the third time this season.

The Falcons swept UW-Stout, 4-1, and 4-3 in overtime, to earn their first conference title since 1996. In the first game at River Falls, Feb. 9, Bucchino mad 36 saves, including 18 in the third period where Stout outshot the Falcons, 18-7. Bucchino came back on Saturday to record 37 saves as the Blue Devils outshot the Falcons, 40-21. In the two games, Bucchino recorded 73 saves for a .948 saves percentage. Bucchino ended the regular season with a 19-4-2 overall record, a 2.22 goals against average and a .931 save percentage.

Also nominated was: UW-Superior forward Chris Berry (Fr, Calgary, Alberta, Canada), UW-Stevens Point forward Ross Johnson (So, International Falls, Minn).

The Week Ahead

Dustin Norman (So, South Delta, BC) scored 46 seconds into the overtime period to lift UW-River Falls to a 4-3 overtime win over UW-Stout Saturday in Menomonie and the Falcons claimed the top seed in the NCHA Peters Cup playoffs. The Falcons will open the playoffs Friday, Feb. 16 by hosting Lake Forest College.

St. Norbert earned the No. 2 seed, while UW-Stout is the No. 3 seed. River Falls, St. Norbert and Stout all share the NCHA regular season title as tri-champions with identical 10-3-1 conference records. It is the first NCHA title for the Falcons since 1996. The title is the Green Knights' sixth consecutive title. The title is the first for the Blue Devils, who have posted their best record in school history.

St. Norbert will host UW-Eau Claire, while Stout will host UW-Stevens Point. UW-Superior earned the No. 4 seed and will host St. Scholastica.

The quarterfinal playoffs are Friday, Feb. 16 and Saturday, Feb. 17. The first round is a two-game series, with a mini-game, if necessary on the second night.

The winners will advance to the semi-final game scheduled for Saturday, Feb. 24 at the highest seeded teams. The top seeded team remaining will host the lowest seeded team remaining, and the second seeded team will host second-lowest seed remaining.

St. Norbert returned to the No. 2 spot in the USCHO.com Division III poll, while River Falls slid up to No. 3. Stout slipped to No. 5, and UW-Superior stayed at No. 7. St. Scholastica was still receiving votes.
