## Pointers' Butler named NCHA player of the week

**MENOMONIE, Wis.** (January 15, 2007) - UW-Stevens Point forward **Tracy Butler (Fr, Marshfield)** had a hand in the Pointers' final two goals in a come-from-behind 5-4 win over St. Olaf and was named the NCHA player of the week.

Butler tied the game with the Oles, Jan. 9, on a goal with 8:57 remaining in the third period, then got an assist on Jessica Edward's game-winner with 58 seconds remaining. Butler scored her first goal of the game midway through the first period. Later in the week, Butler scored in a 9-1 rout of St. Catherine.

Also nominated were: UW-Eau Claire forward Margaret Campbell (So, Plymouth, Minn) and Finlandia forward Sara Sleik (Jr, Norway, Mich)

## The Week Ahead

This week's games opens with a non-conference barn burner as sixth ranked UW-Stevens Point travels to Gustavus Adolphus, Tuesday, Jan. 16. The Pointers defeated the Gusties earlier in the season, 5-4, when the teams met in Stevens Point, Wis.

The Pointers rolled up the first three goals, all in the first period, but the Gusties answered with two of their own before the end of the period. Stevens Point jumped out to a 5-2 lead in the second, but Gustavus made things interesting with a late second period goal and another two minutes into the third period. Amy Statz made 14 second period saves and 15 third period saves to preserve the win.

Conference play resumes this weekend Saturday, Jan. 20 with a full slate of league games. Lake Forest will be at UW-River Falls, Finlandia will be at UW-Superior and UW-Stevens Point will be at UW-Eau Claire. On Sunday, Jan. 21, the Pointers will be at River Falls and Lake Forest will be at Eau Claire.

Both Lake Forest and UW-River Falls will look to get back on the winning track after dropping two straight games. Superior will

have been idle 13 days when they host Finlandia. Stevens Point defeated and tied River Falls earlier in the season. Eau Claire is riding their second three game winning streak of the season as they prepare to host Stevens Point.

In the latest USCHO.com Division III poll released Jan. 15, Superior stayed at fourth, and Stevens Point stayed at sixth. With two losses last weekend, River Falls fell into the receiving votes category. Lake Forest is also receiving votes.
