## Blugolds' Hebert named NCHA player of the week

**MENOMONIE, Wis.** (January 22, 2007) - UW-Eau Claire **Karen Hebert (Sr, Lakeville, Minn)** scored the game-winning-goal in a 4-3 victory over No. 6 UW-Stevens Point and was named the NCHA player of the week.

Hebert scored the game-winner, a short-handed goal, at 18:58 of the third period, Jan. 20 to give the Blugolds only their second win over the Pointers in school history. On the following day, Hebert scored a goal late in the second period to the game with Lake Forest, then added the assist on the go-ahead goal midway through the third period. Lake Forest came back for a 3-3 tie.

Also nominated were: UW-River Falls forward Jenna Scanlon (Jr, Apple Valley, Minn) and UW-Stevens Point forward Nicole Greenway (So, Sheboygan, Wis.)

## The Week Ahead

Rarely does UW-Stevens Point lose two games in the course of a week, but it happened last week when the Pointers fell to second ranked Gustavus Adolphus, 4-2, and UW-Eau Claire picked up a 4-3 win over the Pointers in conference play.

The Pointers are currently in a tie for third place in the league with Lake Forest, while UW-Superior is on top, one point ahead of UW-River Falls, which was tripped up by Stevens Point, 4-1, on Sunday.

The Falcons and the Yellowjackets drop the puck this Saturday, Jan. 27 in a key matchup at Superior, Wis., their first meeting of the season. The teams play again, Feb. 17-18. Upstart Eau Claire is at Superior in a rare Friday afternoon meeting. Superior took both meetings earlier this season, 2-1, 4-0. The Blugolds are currently one point out of third place.

Finlandia will entertain Eau Claire Saturday and River Falls Sunday.

Lake Forest steps out of league play this

weekend with a pair of exhibition games against Robert Morris.

Looking slightly ahead, Superior will play host to Gustavus Adolphus, Tuesday, Jan. 30 in a match-up of top five powers. Gusties defeated the Yellowjackets in November, 6-2, Superior's first loss of the season.

In the latest USCHO.com Division III poll released Jan. 15, Superior stayed at fourth, and Stevens Point stayed at sixth, but fell into a tie with Manhattanville. UW-River Falls and Lake Forest both disappeared from the Division III poll radar.
