Falcons' Schmitz named NCHA player of the week

MENOMONIE, Wis. (January 29, 2007) - UW-River Falls forward **Stefanie Schmitz (Fr, Farmington, Minn.)** was involved in six of the team's seven goals last weekend and helped the Falcons earn three out of a possible four NCHA points. Schmitz was named the NCHA player of the week.

With the three points the Falcons moved into first place in the NCHA standings. Schmitz set a school record with four goals in the team's 5-3 win at Finlandia on Sunday. She scored four goals and had one assist. In the first period alone, she scored the hat trick and added an assist. Her fourth goal came in the third period. She also tied the school record for points in a game with five. In the team's 2-2 overtime tie at UW-Superior on Saturday she got the lone assist on the game-tying goal that came with 5:52 left in regulation. Hanson is second on the team with eight goals and is tied for the team lead with 16 points.

Also nominated were: UW-Eau Claire goalie Mikaela Jobman (Fr, St. Paul, Minn) and UW-Stevens Point defender Chris Hanson (Sr, South St. Paul, Minn)

The Week Ahead

UW-River Falls picked up three points over the weekend by playing to a 2-2 tie with UW-Superior, then defeating Finlandia, 5-3, to move into first place with the entire month of February play remaining.

But the team that took the biggest step last weekend was UW-Eau Claire, who recorded four points by surprising Superior, 3-1 at Superior in a rare Friday afternoon matinee. The Blugolds continued on with quest, defeating Finlandia, 4-1, to move into third place.

UW-Stevens Point had only one game last week, a non-conference game, and slipped into a tie for fourth, along with Lake Forest, who had two exhibition contests.

Superior will have their hands full when they host second ranked Gustavus Adolphus, Tuesday, Jan. 30. The Yellowjackets will be at Lake Forest, Saturday, Feb. 3, then will tussle in their own mini-Super Bowl as the Yellowjackets travel to Stevens Point Sunday, Feb. 4. Gustavus handed Superior a 6-2 loss

in November and Stevens Point and Superior split their series evenly in the season.

Finlandia will be at Stevens Point Saturday and at Lake Forest Sunday.

The Blugolds and the Falcons will tussle at River Falls on Saturday. Eau Claire won the first meeting of the season, 3-1, but River Falls bounced back for a 1-0 win the following afternoon.

In the latest USHCO.com Division III poll, Superior dropped a spot to fifth and Stevens Point slid two spots to eighth.
