## Pointers' Graves named NCHA player of the week

**MENOMONIE, Wis.** (February 5, 2007) - UW-Stevens Point defender **Rachael Graves (So, Bemidji, Minn)** more than doubled her season total in goals when she scored two goals in the final 10 minutes of 5-3 win over Finlandia, Feb. 3. Graves was named the NCHA player of the week.

Graves scored two power play goals in the final 10 minutes of Saturday's game to break a 3-3 tie and lift the Pointers to a 5-3 win over Finlandia. Graves came into Saturday's game with one goal this season and two career goals.

Also nominated were: UW-River Falls defender Jessie Dyslin (So, South St. Paul, Minn) and Lake Forest goalie Sally Bevis (Sr, Huntington, NY).

## The Week Ahead

UW-Superior picked up three points over the weekend by playing to a 1-1 tie with Lake Forest, then nipping UW-Stevens Point, 1-0, on Super Bowl Sunday to move into a tie with UW-River Falls.

The Yellowjackets made a Vi Theofylatos power play goal midway through the first period standup as Melissa Kunzelman stopped 21 shots, including 11 in the third period.
