Falcons' LeBlanc named NCHA player of the week

MENOMONIE, Wis. (February 12, 2007) - UW-River Falls forward **Cassie LeBlanc (Fr, Anoka, Minn)** had an impressive week, scoring three goals and three assists over three games. LeBlanc was named the NCHA player of the week.

LeBlanc dished out her 10th and 11th assists of the season in a 4-1 win over St. Thomas, Feb. 7, then provided much of the offensive power in a 4-1 win at Lake Forest, Feb. 10, scoring the three goal hat trick and adding an assist to figure into all four goals. On the season, LeBlanc has five goals and 12 assists. Her 17 points is third on the team.

Also nominated were: UW-Eau Claire forward Laura Suppes (Sr, Roseville, Minn) and Lake Forest goalie Ryann McCarthy (Fr, Lombard, Ill).

The Week Ahead

Four teams remain in the hunt for the top spot of the NCHA with two weekends of competition remaining.

UW-River Falls, which is currently in first by two points, split a pair of games last week with Lake Forest. The Falcons have only two games left in their regular season schedule, while the other three teams vying for the top spot - UW-Superior, UW-Stevens Point and Lake Forest - still have four conference games left.

But the games that River Falls does have left are big games as they host Superior Saturday and Sunday. The Falcons could claim the NCHA title outright with a sweep over the Yellowjackets, giving them 22 points. A Falcon win and a tie would give them at least a share of the title. The teams tied, 2-2, on Jan 27 in their first meeting.

Stevens Point plays host to Lake Forest

in a battle of teams that are now in third and fourth. Both teams would need to record a sweep of the series to have a realistic chance for the conference title. Stevens Point took a 4-2 win over the Foresters, Dec. 5, in the teams' first meeting.

In the latest USHCO.com Division III poll, Superior slipped a spot to No. 6, while Stevens Point moved up two spots to No. 7. River Falls is receiving votes.

Pointers' Statz is Division III all-time winning goalie

UW-Stevens Point used a dominating third period to break free from UW-Eau Claire for a 5-2 road victory on Friday and make **Amy Statz (Sr, Wisconsin Rapids, Wis.)** the all-time winningest goalie in NCAA Division III women's hockey history.

After UW-Eau Claire tied the game at 2-2 early in the third period, the Pointers scored three straight goals and outshot the Blugolds 14-2 in the final stanza. UW-Stevens Point

had five different players score goals.

Statz made 13 saves with 10 coming in the second period to improve to 63-17-10 for her four-year career. She passed Carlyne Roy, who played at Plattsburgh State from 2002-05 and Katie Kogut, who played at Middlebury from 2003-06. Statz has all but 12 of the Pointers' victories over the past four seasons and now has 12 wins this season.
