Foresters' McCarthy named NCHA player of the week

MENOMONIE, Wis. (February 19, 2007) - Lake Forest goalie **Ryann McCarthy (Fr, Lombard, Ill)** stopped 34 shots in a 3-1 win over UW-Stevens Point last weekend and was named NCHA player of the week.

Eight days after recording Lake Forest's first-ever victory over UW-River Falls, McCarthy was in goal as the Foresters defeated the Pointers for the first time in program history. She stopped 34-of-35 Pointers shots Feb. 17 as the Foresters clinched a berth in the 2007 O'Brien Cup tournament

Also nominated were: UW-Eau Claire forward Margaret Campbell (So, Plymouth, Minn) and UW-River Falls goalie Amber Lindner (Sr, Moorhead, Minn).

The Week Ahead

Four teams have locked up spots in the NCHA O'Brien Cup playoffs, but the order has yet to be determined.

UW-Eau Claire currently is tied with UW-Stevens Point with 14 points for the fourth place spot. But Eau Claire has finished their league play and the Pointers have two league games against Finlandia remaining. Even if the Pointers would lose both games, both teams would have the same NCHA record (6-7-2). The Pointers get the nod because they hold a greater goal differential in games played between the two teams. Eau Claire won the first meeting, 4-3, but the Pointers took the final two games, 5-2 and 5-1.

Only UW-River Falls or UW-Superior can win the conference regular season crown.

The Falcons are currently sitting in first place with 20 points, but they have wrapped up their conference schedule after splitting with Superior last weekend. The Yellowjackets won the first game, 4-3, but the Falcons kept their conference title hopes alive with a 4-2 home win Sunday.

The Yellowjackets need at least a win and a tie over Lake Forest this weekend to claim the top spot. Superior currently has 18 points. A split with the Foresters would give both Superior and River Falls a 9-4-2 overall record. UW-River Falls holds the tie-breaker over the 'Jackets. The teams went an equal 1-1-1 against each other this year. The teams

tied 2-2 in their first meeting. Superior defeated River Falls, 4-3, Feb. 17, but River Falls came back the following day with a 4-2 win, giving the Falcons a plus-1 goal differential over the Yellowjackets.

Lake Forest, which currently has 15 points, would need two wins at Superior this weekend to take the second place spot.

The Pointers, last year's league champion, could benefit with a Lake Forest sweep over Superior, but not as much as River Falls would. A Lake Forest sweep would hand the Falcons the title and the Foresters would finish second.

In that scenario, Stevens Point would need to sweep Finlandia this weekend to wind up in a tie for third with 18 points. Both Superior and Point would have the same NCHA record (tie-breaker a), neither team holds a goal differential over the other in their three meetings, although Superior won 2-of-3 games. (tiebreaker b - Superior won 3-1 and 1-0 (plus-3), while SP won 4-1 [plus-3]). The deciding tie-breaker would be tiebreaker c - goal differential in all NCHA games. With each team still having two games remaining, Stevens Point has the edge with a plus-10 differential to Superior's plus-9 differential.

In the latest USCHO.com Division III poll, Superior stayed at No. 6, while Stevens Point dropped to 10th. River Falls and Lake Forest are receiving votes.
