Stevens Point's Lankey NCHA player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (February 4, 2008) - UW-Stevens Point forward **Katy Lankey (Sr, Baraboo, Wis)** tallied three goals and an assist and was named the NCHA women's player of the week.

Lankey assisted on the first of the game in a 6-1 win over UW-Eau Claire, Feb. 1, then scored a goal in the second period to help the Pointers to the win. In a Feb. 2 3-3 tie with UW-River Falls, Lankey got the Pointers on the board at the 3:38 mark of the second period after trailing 3-0. Stevens Point added two more goals in the third period, including the game-tying goal by Lankey, making this her first multi-goal game of the season.

Also nominated were: UW-River Falls goalie **Cassie Campbell (Fr, Anchorage, Alaska)**; and UW-Eau Claire forward **Meghan Lorenz (Fr, Minnetonka, Minn)**.

Pointers clinch NCHA O'Brien Cup playoff berth

UW-Superior stayed within striking range of UW-Stevens Point last weekend by winning two games, downing Concordia, 6-0, and Lake Forest, 7-1. Coming into the weekend, the Yellowjackets trailed the Pointers by eight points, but made up one point when UW-River Falls forged a 3-3 tie with Stevens Point.

Stevens Point currently has 26 points with four conference games remaining, while Superior has 19 points with six NCHA games on the docket.

The two teams will meet in a two-game series this weekend at Superior in a matchup that will say a lot about who is the regular season champion. If Stevens Point would get three points out of the weekend, they would salt away the NCHA regular season crown and the top seed in the O'Brien Cup

The Pointers won the first meeting between the teams, 2-1, Dec. 7 in Stevens Point. The Pointers scored two power play goals to take a lead, but Superior cut the lead in half with a goal just before the second intermission.

Pointer goalie D'Andra Phillips stopped all 11 shots Superior sent her way in the third period to earn the win.

Stevens Point will close out their portion of the NCHA schedule Feb. 15-16 when they host Lake Forest.

The Yellowjackets will have four more games after they meet Stevens Point. Superior will be at UW-Eau Claire, Feb. 15-16, then will close out the regular season by hosting Finlandia, Feb. 23-24.

Eau Claire is the only team beside Superior that has any kind of chance to catch Stevens Point. Eau Claire currently has 14 points and would have to win their remaining six NCHA games to tie the Pointers. Eau Claire is at Lake Forest this weekend.

River Falls (13 points) and Lake Forest (11 points) have the best chance for the remaining playoff spots. Finlandia still has an outside chance at securing the fourth playoff spot.

In the latest USCHO.com Division III poll, Stevens Point held their ground with the third spot. Superior moved up to a tie for the eighth spot.

Stevens Point hosts fourth ranked Gustavus Adolphus, Tuesday, Feb. 5.
