## Yellowjackets' Gina Baranzelli NCHA player of the week

Menomonie, Wis. (February 11, 2008) - UW-Superior forward **Gina Baranzelli (Sr, Virginia, Minn)** was named the NCHA women's player of the week after leading her team to a sweep of previously undefeated UW-Stevens Point last weekend.

Superior's Baranzelli scored three goals in the Yellowjackets' sweep last weekend over visiting UW-Stevens Point. The Pointers were 17-0-2 coming into the weekend after 19 games. Baranzelli scored the game-winning goal of Friday night's game, handing the Pointers their first loss of the season, 3-1. Saturday saw Baranzelli start off the scoring with a power-play goal. The Pointers tied the game late into the third forcing overtime. Baranzelli fought off a defending Pointer for a rebound and secured the 2-1 win for the Jackets three minutes into the overtime period.

## Yellowjackets put crimp in Pointers' march to title

Coming into this weekend's games, UW-Stevens Point had gone the entire season without suffering a loss. The Pointers had been tied twice, both times in NCHA games.

UW-Superior put an end to the Pointers' undefeated season by sweeping the series with a 3-1 win, Friday, Feb. 8, then took a 2-1 overtime win the following day in Superior, Wis.

Gina Baranzelli scored both goals for the Yellowjackets in the overtime win. She scored the first goal six minutes into the game. Yellowjacket goalie Rikki Nespor kept the Pointers scoreless until the third period when Kellye Nelson scored with less than four minutes remaining in regulation to force overtime.

Baranzelli came through for the

Yellowjackets, scoring 3:17 into the overtime period to record the sweep.

In the latest USCHO.com Division III poll, the Pointers dropped one place to fourth and the Yellowjackets held firm at eighth. UW-River Falls is still receiving votes.
