## UW-Eau Claire's Stephenson Nabs Player of the Week

**SAINT PAUL, MINN. (December 8, 2009)** – UW-Eau Claire freshman goaltender Brandon Stephenson (Saline, MI / Traverse City, NAHL) has been named player of the week in the NCHA Men's Division for his effort in a three-point weekend for the Blugolds. He made 54 saves on 56 shots in the two-game series against UW-Stout which vaulted UWEC back into the mix in the division race.

On Friday night Stephenson starred with a 24 save shutout in a 3-0 Blugold victory. It was the first league win of the year for UW-Eau Claire. Stephenson was especially good in the third period, making 15 saves and stopping three power play attempts.

Stephenson wasn't perfect on Saturday, but he still managed to hold the Blue Devils to a pair of goals - good enough for a 2-2 overtime tie. UW-Stout struck twice in the opening seven minutes of the first period, but the freshman goalie bounced back and stopped everything from that point on. He ended the night with 30 saves.

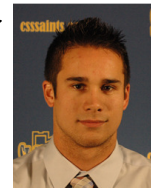
