UWRF's Czuba Crowned Player of the Week

SAINT PAUL, MINN. (February 9, 2010) – Senior forward Tyler Czuba (Kelowna, BC / Swan Valley, MJHL) of UW-River Falls has been named NCHA men's player of the week for his five points last weekend in Falcon victories over UW-Stout and UW-Eau Claire.

In the 3-2 win over UW-Stout on Friday, Czuba assisted on a critical goal for the Falcons in the third period. Trailing 2-1 with less than ten minutes to go, Czuba set up a **Ben Beaudoin** (Inver Grove Heights, Minn / Southern Minnesota, NAHL) power play goal to tie the game. Just over four minutes later, **Josh Calleja** (New Richmond, Wis. / Wisconsin, MJHL) scored the eventual game-winner to send UWRF to a comeback victory.

On Saturday Czuba went off with a hat trick in leading UW-River Falls to a comeback win once again. Trailing 2-1 in the third period, Czuba assisted on a goal that tied the game up. Then at 7:28, Czuba put UWRF in front with his first goal of the night. UW-Eau Claire would tie the game on a penalty shot, but Czuba answered the call again with a goal at 11:50. He completed his hat trick and a four-point night with a power play goal at 19:36.
