St. Scholastica's Kleiman Takes Weekly Award

SAINT PAUL, MINN. (January 26, 2010) – St. Scholastica senior goalie Zach Kleiman (Ottawa, Ontario) has been named player of the week by the NCHA for his strong performance in goal last weekend at UW-Eau Claire. Kleiman posted 49 saves over four periods and allowed just one goal while earning two wins.

Kleiman entered Friday night's game in relief of teammate Brennan Poderzay (Tower, Minn.), who was forced to leave because of injury. And the Blugolds wasted no time in firing a barrage of shots his way as the period started with a 2-2 tie. Kleiman stopped all 19 shots he faced as the Saints pulled away and won 5-2 with an empty-netter.

On Saturday Kleiman was the starting goaltender and he was brilliant again. St. Scholastica was outshot for the second night in a row, but Kleiman turned away 30 of 31 UW-Eau Claire shots to preserve a 2-1 Saints win. His impressive numbers included nine saves in the third period and zero goals against during five UWEC power play attempts.

On the season, Kleiman's goals against sits at 2.28 - third best in the NCHA - and his save percentage is .914. The Saints moved up two spots to #5 in the latest national rankings after the sweep of UW-Eau Claire.

NOTES: St. Norbert's **Brandon Longley** had four points in two wins against UW-Superior ... **Luke Nesper** of UW-Stevens Point scored both goals in a 2-1 Pointer win at UW-River Falls last Saturday ... UW-Stout's **Scott Motz** had a power play goal and an assist in a 3-2 win over St. Olaf at Xcel Energy Center in Saint Paul ... St. Norbert moved up one slot to #3, St. Scholastica moved up two spots to #5 and UW-River Falls fell to #14 in this week's uscho.com poll.
