NCHA Names Monahan SID

St. Paul, Minn. (September 9, 2008) – Brian Monahan has been named sports information director for the Northern Collegiate Hockey Association, Commissioner Bill Kronschnabel announced today.

Monahan is a 2002 graduate of Lake Forest College, where he worked for four years in the sports information and athletic offices. He participated in hockey under coach Tony Fritz before becoming the public address announcer and radio play-by-play voice.

The hiring marks a return of sorts to the NCHA, as Monahan’s first job after college was covering the league for *American College Hockey Magazine*.

“I’m extremely excited to work in this position for the NCHA,” he said. “The league has always been fascinating to me, and the quality of hockey, top to bottom for both the men and women, is exceptional.”

Monahan has a hockey officiating background in addition to journalism, working games for the Minnesota State High School League and the Minnesota Intercollegiate Athletic Conference.

He resides in St. Paul with his wife, Katy, and is a field producer for ESPN on *Monday Night Football*.
